

Baby Surprise Sweater Notes

Notes by Dawn Adcock, for extremely wonderful original design by Elizabeth Zimmermann. Pattern available from Schoolhouse Press, 1-800-YOU-KNIT, Spun Out pattern #1B

Worsted/size 6 (US) needles=5 ½ sts per inch

23" wide sweater

Worsted/size 8 (US) needles=4 sts per inch

25" wide sweater

Sample used about two skeins of Patons Canadiana, 100g (3.5 oz)/228 yards each

Two sides are always same amount of sts, only one side of numbers noted, with center sts next.

The dividing stitch between sections isn't noted, so there are 2 more sts to add to the row total on most rows.

(In other words: stitch counts show the amount of sts on one side, then you have the dividing st, then the center section sts noted next, then the other side after the next dividing st you will also have the same amount that is listed for the first side)

Knit even rows, unless noted otherwise

11: (K3, M1) 9Xs, K2; 76; repeat incs.

25: 31, 62

27: 30, 60

35: 26, 52

37: 25, 50

39: 24, 48

45: Knit (90)

47: 23, 46 (begin incs of M1, K1, M1)

57: 28; M1, (K5, M1) 10Xs, K4, M1; 28

83-99: Knit (18 rows incl. Row 82-10 ridges)

100: K90, PU 10, K34=134

101: K134, PU 10, K34=178

102: K43, pm, K1, pm, K90, pm, K1, pm, K43

103: 44, 92

105: 45, 94

107: 46, 96=190

109: K4, (yo, K2tog, K7) 4Xs, yo, K2tog, K4;

(do incs as normal) 98; repeat button holes

(47 on sides)=194

111: 48, 100

113: 49, 102=202

114: Knit

Bind off Purlwise

Sew shoulders/sleeve tops

Crochet neck edge, or add other collar or trim as desired.
